



## Manufacturer's Certificate of Efficiency

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, provides a tax credit for biomass and wood appliances that have efficiency rating of 75% or greater. The guidelines are outlined by the IRS under Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code.
